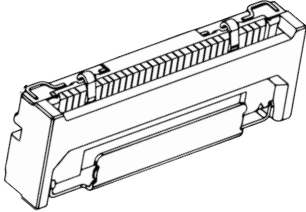

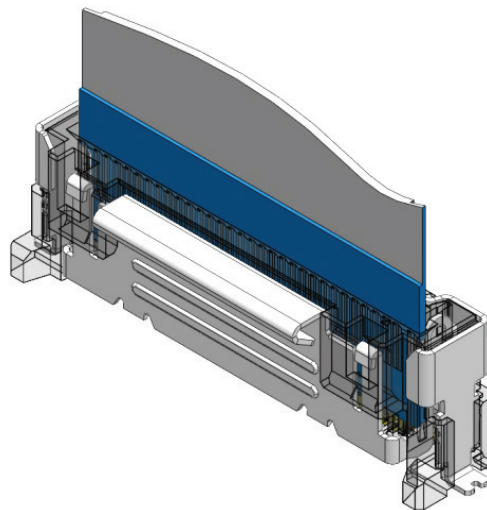
The 11600 Series is a 0.5mm pitch FFC/FPC connector which provides positive locking with IRISO's auto lock engagement feature, Auto I-Lock™. The connector series' characters of signal integrity is tuned to handle 25Gbps+ LVDS. The provided portion comes with or without an EMC drop terminal.

The 11600 Series is identical to our 11501 series, however, the contact type is vertical and is a single contact instead of a right angle, bottom contact.

IRISO's trademarked Auto I-Lock™ does not require secondary operation, such as a slider lock or flip lock after FFC insertion. The provided locking mechanism will engage the FFC into the correct mating position automatically and hold the FFC withstands against extraction forces from every kind of direction. To remove FFC from the housing, there is a provided push-button for releasing the locked FFC.

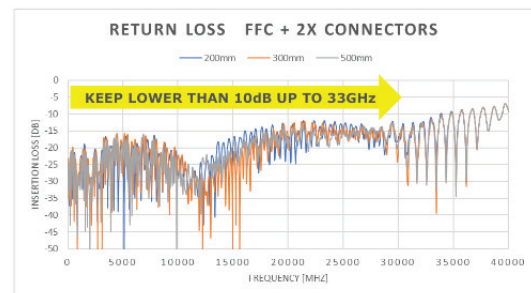
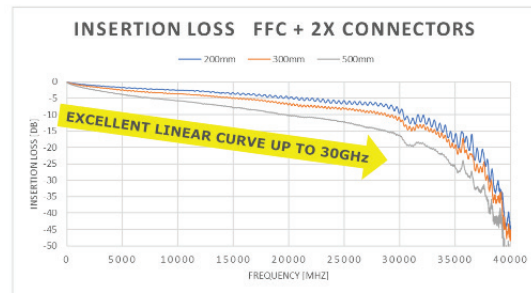
